## Scottish Sports Horse Loose Jumping Championship 2010

Howe Country Centre, Fife was the venue for this year's Scottish Sports Horse Loose Jumping Championship held last weekend (16<sup>th</sup> October 2010) with 27 horses and ponies participating. The red ribbon and £1000 first prize was awarded to "Crockett" (Talan x Torette Isolde VDL x Matterhorn), owned and bred by the Balcormo Farm Partnership, Leven, Fife who scored an impressive 192.5 out of a maximum of 220 points. The bay three year old gelding impressed the judges, James Lister and Alex Moulder, with his correct confirmation, excellent movement and good jumping technique also scooped the prize for the best homebred colt/gelding and was given a portrait from Suzanne Black of Fetlock and Feathers. Sired by Talan, Robert Smith's World Equestrian Games 2010 mount, and a 2012 Olympic hopeful, Crockett will no doubt follow in his father's stride.

Scoring 187.5, second place went to the KWPN registered "Colkitto" by Sunny Boy out of Ursula (who's sire is Lancelot), owned and bred by William Meikle and Aileen Stormonth from Carnwath, Lanarkshire. He was also awarded a basket of grooming products for the best turned out horse, which was kindly donated by Mrs J Halley, SSH Studbook Administrator, with third place going to Balcormo Farm Partnership, this time with the VDL Douglas bred gelding "Cziko" out of Vinini x Emilion.

John Jamieson's JJ's Surefly (Sir Shutterfly x JJ's one Fine Day x Tornado FCS) took fourth place with 184.5 points, and in fifth place was the highest placed homebred filly, "Cierania" scoring 180 points. This filly, owned and bred by Ben Wentink from West Lothian, is by Concretto, who also sired last year's loose jumping winner "Ben Nevis", is out of the Ster mare, Wierania II x Goodtimes. The Balcormo Farm Partnership also took 6<sup>th</sup> place with their homebred filly, "Carlotta" by LC Napenay out of Lotus x Goodtimes, with 178 points.

10 ponies came forward to compete for a first prize of £250 and a portrait by Suzanne Black of Fetlock and Feathers ([www.fetlockandfeathers.co.uk](http://www.fetlockandfeathers.co.uk)). Gaining 174 points and taking first prize was Hugh Paterson's "Miami Gemstone", (Solway Cruise x Ekside Amethyst x Suftom Romany Lane). The Newton Stewart based filly, was also awarded an additional £50 for being the highest placed Scottish bred pony.

Second place, and the best turned out went to "Woodburys Harlequin" owned by P J Lillington from West Lothian. Scoring 170 points it was closely contested competition for the 128cm skewbald gelding, who is by Ferguson Uno (Numero Uno) out of the Waxwing Ster mare "Nightlight" by Moleview Mohawk. Third spot was taken by the Fife based Scholland Stud's filly "Tullibardine Heigh-Ho", by Doylan Cochise out of Tullibardine Halo by Bengad Ramson. "Rydale Rebel" by the Cleveland Bay, Briardale Holling King out of Irish Dancer, scored 163.5 points to take 4<sup>th</sup> place, with fifth being awarded to Fiona Reed's "Puddledub Jeometerry" by Bollin Terry out of Jemina Puddledub by Dixi and Balcormo Farm Partnership again taking 6<sup>th</sup> place with gelding "Charlie Fox" (Whalton Caruso x Sophie x Secundus).
