- ↪ Entry Fee £30
- ↪ Entrant must be SSH member and Horses registered with the SSH.
- ↪ Eligible to ponies measuring under 153cm on day of championships (2cm allowance will be made if shod) and born within 2006.
- ↪ Passports and breed society papers require to be submitted on declaration.
- ↪ **OWNERS MUST DECLARE AND COLLECT BRIDLE NUMBERS FROM 6PM ON THE 16TH OCTOBER FROM SSH SECRETARY.**
- ↪ No hind boots of any description permissible. All ponies must be plaited and be presented in hand with snaffle headpiece.
- ↪ Handlers should be presented in white clothing and footwear.
- ↪ Marks will be awarded by 2 respected Judges on confirmation, movement, scope, technique, take off and personal preference.
- ↪ The marks awarded and decision of the judges will be final. Score sheets will be awarded at end of competition on receipt of bridle numbers at office.

**Entries close strictly on Saturday 26<sup>th</sup> September  
NO LATE ENTRIES ACCEPTED.**

Owners are advised to present their ponies at practise sessions held during Sept & Oct regionally throughout Scotland.

## RULES AND PROCEDURES:

- ↪ All animals must have a passport that clearly states the animal's date of birth. The passport must be submitted to the secretary on arrival, in return the bridle numbers shall be given. A passport /animal crosscheck will be carried out by an SSH official.
- ↪ Two bridle numbers are given, and one worn on each side of the bridle, no animal will be allowed into the ring without wearing the appropriate numbers. On return of the numbers to the secretary, passports can be collected.
- ↪ All handlers must wear white trousers (skirt) sweatshirt (or similar) and running shoes. White sweatshirts and tee shirts can be purchased from SSH.

Method of presentation:

A cage area of approx 50m by 20m will be used.

The pony will be led into the arena by its handler and stood up for the judges.

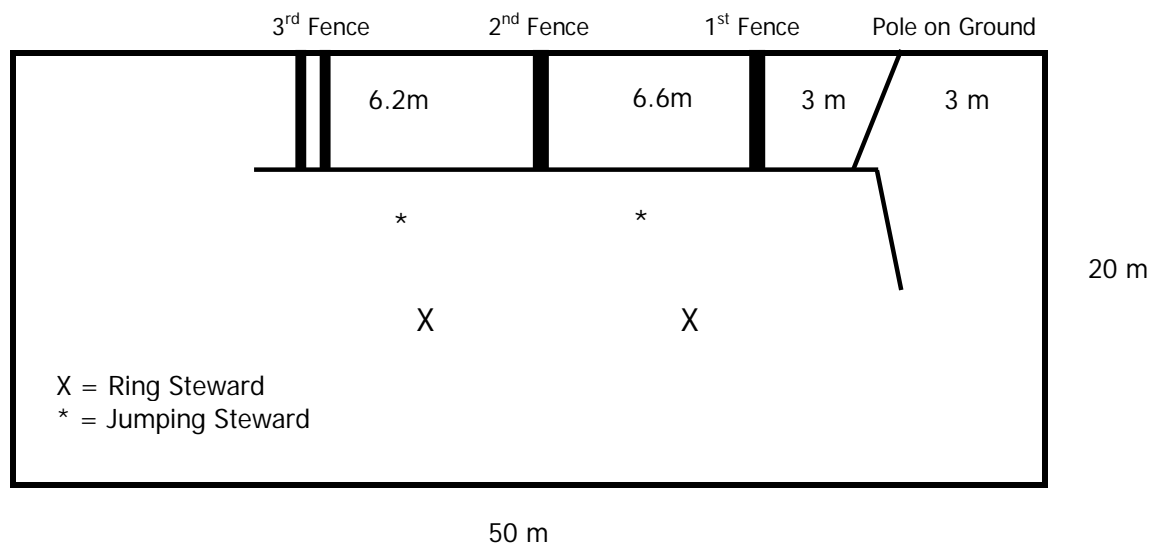
The pony is then let loose and after warming up, the horse will be guided round the arena by experienced ring stewards using an extension of arm. It is not normally the purpose of the ring stewards to touch the horse.

A fence steward erects the fence. The judge(s), steward(s) or handler can have the horse stopped at any time. The handler must remain stationary within the caged area.

It will take approx 6 minutes to complete the test.

Three obstacles with one stride between each will be use on the left rein along the long side of the arena.

See diagram below for distances.



### Maximum height of last obstacle

#### **For 3yr old ponies (Ponies born in 2006)**

Ponies declared as 133cm and under      95cm  
Ponies declared as 143cm and under      1 metre  
Ponies declared as 153cm and under      1.05 metres

### Distances

#### **From obstacle 1 to 2 will be as follows:**

Ponies declared as 133cm and under      6.0 metres  
Ponies declared as 143cm and under      6.3 metres  
Ponies declared as 153cm and under      6.6 metres

**From obstacle 2 to 3 will be as follows:**

Ponies declared as 133cm and under 6.2 metres  
Ponies declared as 143cm and under 6.5 metres  
Ponies declared as 153cm and under 6.8 metre

Scoring: Judges must assess the ponies as a sports pony, as if buying the pony for themselves.

If marks are equal, the horse with the highest marks for technique will be the winner. Continuing equal marks will then be resolved by taking the marks for scope, movement, conformation and attitude IN THAT ORDER to determine the winner.

- Ensure details provided are accurate and legible. These will be typed as written.
- Applications must be accompanied by an **ORIGINAL** identification sketch that has been completed, signed and stamped by an **M.R.CV.S.** (Vaccination certificates will be returned once copied) only original must be sent, photo copies are not acceptable and will be returned. Sketches which have been amended or altered must be signed at the relevant alterations by the vet who completed the sketch.
- All documents for proof of pedigree must be originals, and must be fully completed- please check that covering certificates etc, are signed, dated and numbered. Covering certificates are retained by the society.
- DNA/Parentage testing is now compulsory for all foals registered, mares & stallions (or any animal born from 2007) Micro chipping will be compulsory for all foals & new registration from 1<sup>st</sup> July 2009.
- Cheques should be made payable to Scottish Sports Horse. Registrations will not be processed without payment.
- Allow 4 weeks for processing where ALL required information has been supplied.
- Ensure form is signed and dated.

**ANY HORSE/PONY CAN BE REGISTERED WITH THE SSH**

I understand that since 01.07.00 by (EU) law, every horse (pony, donkey, and mule) must have a passport. If your horse already has a passport, it is enclosed so that it can be over stamped to record the horse's registration with the SSH. I understand that it is illegal to obtain a second passport for my horse.
